	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2067, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1993, c.
4	683, Pt. A, $\S2$ and affected by Pt. B, $\S5$, is amended to read:
6	2. Dimming. When a vehicle equipped with multiple-beam road lights approaches an oncoming vehicle within 500 feet or
8	follows a vehicle within 300 feet, the operator shall dim the headlights or switch to a low beam and shall turn off a fog or
10	auxiliary light allowed by section 2054, subsection 2, paragraph E that-exceeds-20,000-candlepower.

14	SUMMARY
16	Under current law, when approaching an oncoming vehicle or
	following a vehicle, the operator of a motor vehicle must turn
18	off fog lights or auxiliary lights that exceed 20,000 candlepower. This bill expands that requirement to apply to all
20	fog lights and auxiliary lights.
