2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§3,** as amended by PL 1993, c.
206, §5 and affected by §7, is repealed.

6 **Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§3-A** is enacted to read:

8 **3-A. Moose hunting season.** The open season on moose in
10 each calendar year is the last 6 days in October, excluding
Sunday.

14 This bill changes the moose hunting season to the last 6
