2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§3-A, is enacted to read:**

6 3-A. Hunting day limited to residents. The Saturday
8 preceding the first day of open season on moose, established
10 pursuant to subsection 3, is an open day for residents of this
12 State holding permits.

10 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill provides a day for resident hunters only to hunt
14 moose.
