Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1905, as amended by PL 1975, c. 293, §4, is
further amended to read:

### §1905. Funds

The Department of Human Services is authorized to receive and disburse such funds as that may be available to it for family planning services to any nonprofit organization, public or private, engaged in providing such services except that the department may not provide funding to the Family Planning Association of Maine, Inc. Family-planning-programs-administered by-the-Department-of-Human-Services-may-be-developed-in consultation, coordination-or-on-a-contractual-basis, with-other family-planning-agencies-in-this-State, -including, -but-not limited-to, the-Family-Planning-Association-of-Maine, -Inc., and its-affiliates.

#### **SUMMARY**

This bill prohibits the Department of Human Services from providing funding to the Family Planning Association of Maine, Inc.
