2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §908, sub-§4** is enacted to read:

6 4. Legislative approval necessary. The Baxter State Park
8 Authority must submit a request to and receive authorization from
10 the Legislature before destroying or removing any bridge, road or
12 other artificial structure within the park.

14 **SUMMARY**

This bill prohibits the Baxter State Park Authority from destroying or removing any road, bridge or other artificial structure without approval of the Legislature.
