	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec.1. 12 MRSA §554-A is enacted to read:
4 6	<u>§554-A. Public access to lands conveyed for inclusion in a national park</u>
8	The director shall ensure that any conveyance of public lands or public reserved lands to the Federal Government for
10	inclusion in a national park includes a reservation of rights for the public to hunt, fish and trap and to have free noncommercial
12	vehicular access to the conveyed lands.

	This bill requires the Director of the Bureau of Parks and
18	Lands to ensure that public lands and public reserved lands conveyed to the Federal Government for inclusion in a national
20	park are conveyed with a reserved right of public access for hunting, trapping and fishing and free vehicular access for
