An Act to Authorize a State Agency to Charge Interest on Money Owed to that Agency.

The required payment date for any fines imposed by state departments or agencies, for money due the State in the normal course of business or for the repayment of duplicate payments or overpayments, is no more than 25 working days from the date the responsible party receives an invoice from the state department or agency, unless the responsible party and the state department or agency have agreed to another date. Sister Assessment of interest In the event that fines or other payments or repayments due the State are not paid within 25 working days after receipt of the invoice by the responsible party or within 15 days following another date agreed to by the state department or agency and the responsible party, the state department or agency may charge a reasonable interest rate on the overdue payment. Sister receipt of the interest charge permitted under section 1562 applies to the period beginning on the day after the required payment is due
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
