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Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§371-B." by inserting after subsection 1 the following:

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'2. Filling vacancies. Vacancies in the office of sheriff caused by death, resignation, removal from the county, permanent incapacity or any other reason must be filled as provided in the Constitution of Maine.'

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Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated " $$371-B_{\bullet}$ " in subsection 2 in the first line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2." and inserting in its place the following: '3.'

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Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "\$371-B." in subsection 2 in paragraph A in the first line (page 1, line 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "attests to" and inserting in its place the following: 'swears to or affirms'

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Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§371-B." in subsection 2 by inserting after paragraph A the following:

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'B. The candidate has never been convicted of a Class C or higher crime;'

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Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§371-B." in subsection 2 in paragraph B in the first line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: inserting in its place the following: 'C.'

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40	SUMMARY
40	This amendment clarifies the bill, which established minimum
42	qualifications for candidates for election or appointment to the office of county sheriff. The amendment clarifies that a
44	candidate for sheriff may not have been convicted of a Class C or

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higher crime, clarifies the applicability of the Law Enforcement Code of Ethics to candidates for sheriff and "grandfathers"

anyone who is not currently serving as sheriff but who previously

served in that capacity from the minimum qualifications imposed

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by the bill.
