**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

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**Sec. 1. 39-A MRSA §218, sub-§4, ¶A,** as enacted by PL 1991, c. 885, Pt. A, §8 and affected by §§9 to 11, is repealed.

**SUMMARY**

This bill amends the Maine Workers' Compensation Act of 1992 in the statutes that address worker reinstatement rights. It repeals language that specifies that an employer is not obligated to reinstate an employee in supervisory or confidential positions.
