An Act to Allow Municipal Law Enforcement Officials to Enforce Handicapped Parking Restrictions.

- Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §3009, sub-§1, ¶D, as amended by PL 1995, c. 65, Pt. A, §128 and affected by §153 and Pt. C, §15, is further 4 amended to read: 6 D. The following provisions apply to the establishment and 8 policing of parking spaces for handicapped persons. 10 (1) Municipal public parking areas are subject to any applicable requirements of the Maine Human Rights Act, 12 Title 5, chapter 337, subchapter V. The municipality shall post a sign adjacent to and visible from each 14 handicapped space established parking by the municipality. The sign display the shall must 16 international symbol for accessibility. 18 (2)--Owners-of-private-off-street-parking-shall-arrange for-private-enforcement-or-shall-enter-into-agreements 20 with--local--or--county--law--enforcement--agencies--to enforce-handicapped-parking-restrictions---Under-these 22 agreements, - unauthorized - vehicles will be - ticketed - - An owner--of--private--off-street--parking--who--fails--to 24 arrange-for-private-enforcement-or-to-enter-into-an agreement-with-a-law enforcement agency commits -a-civil 26 vielation-for-which-a-forfeiture-of-net-less-than-\$50 may-be-adjudged. Handicapped parking restrictions may be enforced by local and county law enforcement 28 officials, county or municipal volunteer parking 30 enforcement specialists as provided in sections 471 and 472, or persons with whom the owner of a private 32 off-street parking area has entered an agreement for enforcement. 34 Under-these-agreements, -public Public law enforcement officials may ensure that parking spaces designated for 36 the handicapped are used appropriately by handicapped 38 persons, whether the designated handicapped parking spaces are located on public lots or on private lots 40 open to the public. Handieapped-parking-restrictions in-private--lots-may--also--be--enforced-by--county--or 42 municipal-volunteer-parking-enforcement-specialists-as provided-in-sections-471-and-472. 44
- 46 Where service facilities are established on the Maine 46 Turnpike and on the interstate highway system in the 5tate, the State Police shall enforce any handicapped 48 parking restrictions at those facilities.

(3) Any vehicle or motorcycle parked in a parking space clearly marked as a handicapped parking space and that does not bear a special registration plate or placard issued under Title 29-A, section 521 or 523, or a similar plate issued by another state, must be <u>towed</u> <u>immediately and</u> cited for a forfeiture of not less than \$50 for the first violation and \$100 for each <u>subsequent violation</u>. "Clearly marked" includes painted signs on pavement and vertical standing signs that are visible in existing weather conditions.

SUMMARY

This bill authorizes local law enforcement officials to enforce handicapped parking restrictions on private as well as public property, increases the fee for 2nd and subsequent violations of handicapped parking restrictions and requires that vehicles illegally parked in spaces reserved for handicapped parking be towed immediately.
