	Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §4206, sub-§10 is enacted to read:

	10. Maintenance of public springs. The commissioner shall
6	<u>make every effort to maintain public springs on property under</u>
	the department's jurisdiction. The commissioner shall allow
8	municipalities or county commissioners in unorganized territories
	<u>to arrange and pay for tests of those springs to verify</u>
10	compliance with applicable state and federal laws on drinking
	water guality. If the spring meets all applicable state and
12	federal standards, the department shall maintain or allow the
	<u>municipality or county to maintain the spring as a source of</u>
14	water for the public.
