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SUMMARY

4 The bill permits a campground owner to deny accommodations to any person who violates any rule of the campground that is 6 posted in a conspicuous manner at the guest registration desk and at the campground site. This amendment eliminates the 8 requirement that the rules be posted at each campground site.
