Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §§1710-F and 1710-G, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 368, Pt. J, §1, are amended to read:

6 §1710-F. Duties of committee

Duties; use of economic assumptions. The committee 8 1. shall develop current fiscal biennium and 2 ensuing fiscal revenue projections using 10 biennium biennia the economic assumptions recommended by the Consensus Economic Forecasting 12 Commission.

14 2. Biennial revenue projections. The committee shall submit recommendations for state revenue projections for the next 2 fiscal biennium biennia and analyze revenue projections for the 16 current fiscal biennium, which must be approved by a majority of No later than December 1st of each the committee members. 18 even-numbered year, the committee shall submit to the Governor, the Legislative Council, the joint standing committee of the 20 Legislature having jurisdiction over appropriations and financial affairs and the State Budget Officer a report that presents the 22 analyses, findings and recommendations for General Fund and Highway Fund revenue projections for the next 2 fiscal biennium 24 biennia. In its report the committee shall fully describe the methodology employed in reaching its recommendations. 26 Revenue projections for other funds of the State may be included in the report at the discretion of the committee. 28

Current and ensuing biennium adjustments. No later than 30 3. March 1st and December 1st annually the committee shall submit to 32 the Governor, the Legislative Council, the joint standing the Legislature having jurisdiction committee of over appropriations and financial affairs and the State Budget Officer 34 a report that presents the analyses, findings and recommendations for adjustments to General Fund revenue and Highway Fund revenue 36 for the current and ensuing fiscal biennium biennia. In each report the committee shall fully describe the methodology 38 employed in reaching its recommendations. Revenue adjustments for other funds of the State may be included in the report at the 40 discretion of the committee.

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§1710-G. Use of revenue forecasts

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Budget Officer consider State shall the The revenue projections recommended by the committee in setting revenue 46 estimates in accordance with section 1665, subsection 3. The State Budget Officer shall use the revenue projections of the 48 committee in preparing General Fund and Highway Fund revenue and expenditure forecasts in accordance with section 1664 and section 50 1665, subsection 7. If the State Budget Officer adjusts the revenue projections recommended by the committee <u>in setting</u> revenue estimates in accordance with section 1665, subsection 3, the State Budget Officer shall submit to the Governor, the Legislative Council and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over appropriations and financial affairs a report that presents the analyses, findings and recommendations by revenue line and explains the variances from the revenue projections recommended by the committee.

SUMMARY

This bill requires the Revenue Forecasting Committee to 14 prepare and recommend 4-year revenue forecasts for the General Fund and the Highway Fund.

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
