COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 132, L.D. 174, Bill, "An Act to Increase Health Insurance Benefits for Retired Educators"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
