HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 132, L.D. 174, Bill, "An Act to Increase Health Insurance Benefits for Retired Educators"


Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in the last line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "insurance" the following: 'as long as the amount does not exceed 30% of the total average costs of health insurance provided to an individual retired state employee'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment may result in General Fund savings to the Retired Teachers' Health Insurance account within the Department of Education if the health insurance costs of any retired teacher exceed 30% of the average cost of health insurance for a retired state employee.

SUMMARY

This amendment limits the amount that the State contributes towards a retired teacher's share of health insurance up to 30% of the total average cost of health insurance made available by the State to an individual retired state employee.
