HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 132, L.D. 174, Bill, "An Act to Increase Health Insurance Benefits for Retired Educators"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT OF
Retired Teachers' Health Insurance

All Other \$634,290

Provides funds to increase the State's share of retired teachers' health insurance from 25% to 30%.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

The Retired Teachers' Health Insurance account within the Department of Education will require an additional General Fund appropriation of \$634,290 in fiscal year 1998-99 to increase the State's share of retired teachers' health insurance from 25% to 30%. This estimate is based on an assumed effective date of August 1, 1998.'
