COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 135, L.D. 177, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Child Labor Laws to Prohibit Minors 14 Years of Age from Working in a Restaurant or Eating Place"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act to Amend the Child Labor Laws as They Pertain to Employment of Minors 15 Years of Age'**

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment deletes from the original bill the prohibition on minors 14 years of age working in a restaurant or eating establishment.
