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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 65, L.D. 184, Bill, "An Act to Decrease the Time Period Allowed for the Rescission of a Time-share Contract"

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Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A in subparagraph (2) in division (b) in the 2nd line (page 1, line 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "SEVEN" and inserting in its place the following: 'TEN CALENDAR'

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Further amend the bill in section 2 in subparagraph (10) division (a) in the first line (page 1, line 44 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "7" and inserting in its place the following: '10 calendar'

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Further amend the bill in section 2 in subparagraph (12) in the 4th line (page 2, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "7" and inserting in its place the following: '10 calendar'

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Further amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 3 in the 4th line (page 2, line 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "7" and inserting in its place the following: '10 calendar' and in the 5th line (page 2, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "7" and inserting in its place the following: '10 calendar'

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**SUMMARY**

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The original bill decreases the time period allowed for the rescission of a time-share contract from 15 days to 7 days. This amendment increases the time period allowed for rescission from 7 days to 10 calendar days.
