2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15907, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:**

6 1-A. State's share limited. The State's share must be
8 based on a cost per square foot not exceeding \$80. The State's
10 share may be used only for facilities related to essential
12 services. The commissioner may adopt rules to define essential
14 services. These rules are major substantive rules as defined in
16 Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.

SUMMARY

This bill limits the State's reimbursement for public school construction and renovation projects.
