34	'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6862, sub-§§2 and 4, as corrected by RR 1991, c. 2, §38, are amended to read:
36	2. Permitted activity. A lobster tail permit authorizes a
38	wholesale seafood license holder to remove <u>a</u> lobster tails-in-the shell <u>tail</u> from <u>a</u> lobster <u>and to process that whole lobster tail</u>
40	or portions of that lobster tail under the following conditions.
42	A. The lobster tails tail or lobster tail portions may enly be processed <u>only</u> at the establishment named in the permit.
44	B. The tails lobster tail or lobster tail portions may only
46	come from <u>a</u> legal sized lebsters <u>lobster</u> , as defined in section 6431.
48	C. All containers in which lobster tails <u>or lobster tail</u>
50	portions are packed to be sold, shipped or transported must be clearly labeled with the name, address and permit number

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 157, L.D. 199

2 The commissioner, in accordance with the 4. Regulations. Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375, may adopt such regulations as are deemed <u>determined</u> necessary for 4 implementation and enforcement of this section. These regulations 6 may include provisions for determining that lobster tails or lobster tail portions processed by a wholesale seafood license holder under this section were removed by that wholesale seafood 8 license holder from legal sized lobsters and other provisions as 10 may be deemed determined necessary.'
