16 SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 72, L.D. 211, Bill, "An Act to
Permit Municipalities to Restrict the Sale of Tobacco Products"

18 Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting
20 clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the
following:


22 'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1556, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 470, §9 and
24 affected by §19, is repealed and the following enacted in its
place:

26 §1556. Municipal regulation

28 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, a municipality
30 may, by local referendum pursuant to Title 30-A, chapter 121,
prohibit the sale of tobacco products.'

34 SUMMARY

36 This amendment strikes the entire bill, which removed the
prohibition on municipalities regulating tobacco sales, and
38 instead allows a municipality to vote to completely ban the sale
of tobacco products.
