Organization. The State Tax Assessor may employ such deputies, assistants and employees as necessary, subject to the Civil Service Law, --as--are-necessary unless otherwise provided, and distribute the duties given to him the assessor or to the Bureau of Taxation among such those persons or divisions in that bureau as-he-deems the assessor considers necessary for economy and efficiency in administration. An officer within each division of the bureau shall must be designated by the State-Tax-Assesser assessor as director of that division. Notwithstanding any other laws, the Director of Econometric Research serves at the pleasure The State---Tax---Assesser of the assessor. assessor, enforcement and administrative purposes, may divide the State into a reasonable number of districts in which branch offices may be maintained.
