2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1401, sub-§4,** as affected by PL 1995, c.  
65, Pt. A, §153; as amended by Pt. B, §15 and affected by Pt. C,  
§15, is further amended to read:

8 **4. Fee.** In addition to the license fee, the photograph fee  
is \$3. A person who renews a license on or after that person's  
10 65th birthday is exempt from paying the \$3 photograph fee.

16 This bill exempts people 65 years of age or older from  
18 paying the additional \$3 photograph fee.
