HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 80, L.D. 219, "Resolve, to Establish Qualifications for Constitutional Officers"


Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd and 3rd paragraphs after the title (page 1, lines 28 to 38 in amendment).

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the 4th paragraph before the fiscal note (page 2, lines 13 and 14 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 7. Compensation. Resolved: That compensation, including expenses and per diem, may not be paid to any Legislator or other member of the commission; and be it further'

SUMMARY

This amendment restores to the Commission to Establish the Criteria and Qualifications for Certain State Officers the legislative members that were removed by the committee amendment. This amendment also clarifies that a Legislator or other member of the commission may not be compensated in any manner.
