HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 80, L.D. 219, "Resolve, to Establish Qualifications for Constitutional Officers"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd and 3rd paragraphs after the title (page 1, lines 28 to 38 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

'Further amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency preamble'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in the 3rd line from the end (page 2, line 2 in amendment) by striking out the following: "August 1, 1997" and inserting in its place the following: 'September 15, 1997'

Further amend the amendment in the 6th paragraph before the fiscal note in the last line (page 2, line 7 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and 7" and inserting in its place the following: 'to 8'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the 3rd and 4th paragraphs before the fiscal note (page 2, lines 13 to 21 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

'Sec. 7. Compensation. Resolved: That compensation, including expenses and per diem, may not be paid to any Legislator or other member of the commission; and be it further

Sec. 8. Report. Resolved: That the commission shall submit its report, together with any necessary implementing

2 legislation, to the Second Regular Session of the 118th
4 Legislature and the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local
6 Government no later than January 1, 1998. The Joint Standing
8 Committee on State and Local Government is authorized to report
out legislation regarding the qualifications of constitutional
officers and the State Auditor to the Second Regular Session of
the 118th Legislature.

10 Further amend the resolve by striking out all of the
emergency clause.'

SUMMARY

16 This amendment strikes the emergency preamble and emergency
18 clause from the resolve. The amendment changes the first meeting
of the Commission to Establish the Criteria and Qualifications
for Certain State Officers from August 1, 1997 to September 15,
1997. It also changes the reporting date of the commission to
20 the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government from
November 1, 1997 to January 1, 1998.

22 This amendment restores to the Commission to Establish the
24 Criteria and Qualifications for Certain State Officers the
legislative members that were removed by the committee
26 amendment. This amendment also clarifies that a Legislator or
other member of the commission may not be compensated in any
28 manner.
