

An Act to Amend the Charter of the Madison Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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4 **Sec. 1. P&SL 1913, c. 121, §7, 3rd ¶**, as repealed and replaced by
P&SL 1993, c. 69, §1, is amended to read:

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8 Whenever the term of office of a trustee expires, the
10 trustee's successor must be elected by a plurality vote by the
12 legal voters of the ~~district~~ Town of Madison for a term of 3
14 years. If a vacancy arises, it must be filled for the remainder
of the year by appointment by the remaining trustees, and at the
next ~~regular meeting of the district~~ municipal election of the
Town of Madison the vacancy must be filled for the unexpired term
by a special election to be called by the trustees of the
district.

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SUMMARY

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20 This bill amends the charter of the Madison Water District
to correct an error and to clarify the process for filling a
vacancy on the board of trustees.
