2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §651, sub-§1, ¶E is repealed and the following
4	enacted in its place:
б	E. Public municipal corporations and public quasi-municipal corporations engaged in supplying water, power or light,
8	including the system or part of the system used to supply water, power or light, or any property, real or personal,
10	constituting a part of such a system, whether located within or outside the corporate limits of the corporation, or the
12	income from those facilities.

18	This bill extends to those public municipal and quasi-municipal corporations that supply water, power or light
20	the same exemption from taxation enjoyed by revenue-producing municipal facilities as provided under the Maine Revised
22	Statutes, Title 30-A, section 5413.
