

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §651, sub-§1, ¶E** is repealed and the following
enacted in its place:

6 E. Public municipal corporations and public quasi-municipal
8 corporations engaged in supplying water, power or light,
10 including the system or part of the system used to supply
12 water, power or light, or any property, real or personal,
 constituting a part of such a system, whether located within
 or outside the corporate limits of the corporation, or the
 income from those facilities.

16 **SUMMARY**

18 This bill extends to those public municipal and
20 quasi-municipal corporations that supply water, power or light
the same exemption from taxation enjoyed by revenue-producing
22 municipal facilities as provided under the Maine Revised
Statutes, Title 30-A, section 5413.
