2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7794, sub-§4**, as amended by PL 1989, c. 493,
§52, is further amended to read:

6 **4. Fees.** The fees for each original or renewal certificate
of number with 2 validation stickers are as follows:

- 8
- 10 A. All watercraft requiring or requesting certificate of
number\$4
- 12 B. Duplicate certificate of number\$1
- 14 C. Duplicate validation sticker (per set)\$1
- 16 D. Certificate of number issued with transfer of ownership
18 authorized in subsection 7\$2

20 The owner of a watercraft powered by an electric motor is exempt
from the fees in this subsection.
