Sec. 1. Amend commercial vehicle inspection standards. Resolved:

2 That the Department of Public Safety, Chief of the State Police
3 shall amend the rules for the inspection of commercial vehicles
4 as required by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29-A, section
5 1753, subsection 2 to require that the part on diesel systems in
6 commercial vehicles called injectors is a component to be
7 inspected.

10 **SUMMARY**

11 This resolve instructs the Chief of the State Police to
12 amend the Motor Vehicle Inspection Manual to include diesel
13 injectors in the exhaust systems of the commercial vehicle
14 section. This part to be inspected affects diesel fuel emissions.
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
