SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 179, L.D. 234, Bill, "An Act to Extend Access to Chiropractic Care under Health Maintenance Organization Managed Care Plans"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in the next to last paragraph in the 2nd to 4th lines (page 2, lines 13 to 15 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "except a contract between a health maintenance organization and the State Employee Health Insurance Program" and inserting in its place the following: 'except-a-contract-between-a-health-maintenance-organization-and the-State-Employee-Health-Insurance-Program'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 1 and 28 before the summary the following:

- 30 'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

The costs for employees 46 paid by other funds estimated to be \$63,998 and \$85,330, respectively, may require increased allotments to meet these 48 additional personal services expenditures.
