Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1974, sub-§5-A is enacted to read:

5-A. Reimbursement to municipalities for fire and rescue services. At the request of a municipality, the authority shall reimburse the municipality for the cost of municipal services provided in response to an emergency on the turnpike. The authority shall develop a form for a municipality to use when requesting reimbursement. The authority may require a municipality to provide information specific to the services provided and insurance information on the recipients of the emergency services to facilitate recovery of costs.

SUMMARY

18 This bill requires the Maine Turnpike Authority to reimburse municipalities for the cost of emergency services provided in response to an emergency on the turnpike.
