Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §275-N, 2nd ¶, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 408,
§14, is repealed.

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SUMMARY

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This bill repeals the provision of law that requires every commercial track that is licensed for a specific calendar year to be given all the race dates it requests if it conducted live racing on those dates during the immediately preceding calendar year.
