Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §275-N, 2nd \P , as enacted by PL 1995, c. 408, $\S14$, is repealed.

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SUMMARY

This bill repeals the provision of law that requires every commercial track that is licensed for a specific calendar year to be given all the race dates it requests if it conducted live racing on those dates during the immediately preceding calendar year.
