SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 204, L.D. 257, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Liquor Laws"

Amend the amendment on page 2 by striking out all of the 5th indented paragraph (page 2, lines 27 and 28 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 4.

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment eliminates the General Fund revenue reductions of \$2,400 annually in fiscal year 1997-98 and 1998-99.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes that provision of Committee Amendment "A" that extends to restaurants the ability to obtain an auxiliary license in a separate building.
