HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 207, L.D. 260, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Task Force on Production and Issuance of Registration Plates"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of subparagraph (3) (page 1, line 27 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'(3) A white plate with no illustration having a dark blue line around the border of the plate and dark blue letters or numbers and the word "MAINE" in red at the top of the plate.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment will result in minor savings in license plate production costs.

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the provision in Committee Amendment "B" that requires license plates with an illustration of the West Quoddy Head light and replaces it with language describing a plate that is the same as the current lobster license plate, but without the lobster and without the word "Vacationland."
