HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 207, L.D. 260, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Task Force on Production and Issuance of Registration Plates"

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §451, sub-§4, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is repealed.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment may result in some minor savings in plate production costs to the Department of the Secretary of State.

SUMMARY

This amendment repeals the requirement that registration plates contain the word "Vacationland."
