This amendment makes the following substantive changes to the bill.

16 18 1. It requires that any exemption from the provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35-A, section 2102 for any telephone utility be adopted by rule. The rules are major substantive rules.

2. It makes explicit the commission's ability to revoke an exemption in whole or in part. This includes the ability to revoke an exemption for a single telephone utility.
