An Act to Create a License Plate for Women Veterans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §524, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

5. Woman veteran special license plate. The Secretary of
State, on application and upon evidence of payment of the excise tax required by Title 36, section 1482, shall issue a
registration certificate and set of special designating plates, to be used in lieu of regular registration plates, to any Maine
resident who is a woman who has served in the United States Armed Forces and who has been honorably discharged. If a woman veteran
is the primary driver of 2 vehicles, the Secretary of State may issue in accordance with this section a set of special veterans
registration plates for each vehicle.

16 Each application must be accompanied by the applicant's Armed Forces Report of Transfer or Discharge, DD Form 214, or 18 certification from the United States Veterans Administration or the appropriate branch of the United States Armed Forces 20 verifying the applicant's military service and honorable discharge.

- All surplus revenue collected for issuance of the special 24 registration plates is retained by the Secretary of State to maintain and support this program.
- These special designating plates must be of a design as determined by the Secretary of State. The Secretary of State shall begin issuing these plates in accordance with this subsection after July 1, 1999.

SUMMARY

This bill establishes a specialty license plate for veterans who are women and who have been honorably discharged. This plate is to be distinguished from the regular veterans plate and will be issued after July 1, 1999.
