COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 86, L.D. 266, Bill, "An Act to Conform State Laws Regarding Fair Housing for Older Persons with Federal Laws"

Amend the bill section 1 in paragraph C by striking out all of the first 6 lines (page 1, lines 6 to 11 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

'C. Intended and operated for occupancy by at least one person 55 years of age or older per unit. In determining whether housing qualifies as housing for older persons under this paragraph, ~~regulations--adopted--by--the--United--States Department--of--Housing--and--Urban--Development--shall--be--used which--require~~ the housing must meet at least the following factors.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment deletes a reference to regulations adopted by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development to be consistent with the removal of the language requiring significant facilities and services as defined by HUD regulation in the original bill.
