SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 88, L.D. 268

Fund bond issue, including \$500,000 for mitigation of storm water pollution through the establishment of a comprehensive watershed protection program, is approved by the voters of the State.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any 6 nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

## SUMMARY

12 This amendment adds a provision to limit the use of bond proceeds allocated to a priority watershed protection program to 14 finance capital improvements and to purchase tangible assets with useful lives greater than 10 years.

It also adds a technical correction concerning the 18 implementation of the priority watershed protection grants program. 20
