8	guide as required by Title 12, section 7311, as long as that employment is not subject to federal unemployment

12	(39) Services performed by a direct seller as defined in 26 United States Code, Section 3508, Subsection (b),
14	Paragraph (2). This subparagraph does not include a person selling major improvements or renovations to the
16	structure of a home, business or property.; and
18	Sec. 2. 26 MRSA §1043, sub-§11, ¶F, as corrected by RR 1995, c. 2, §62, is amended by enacting subparagraph (40) to read:
20	(40) Services performed by a person who owns and
22	operates a vehicle that is used as a taxicab.

28	For unemployment compensation purposes, this bill exempts from the definition of employment taxi drivers who own and
30	operate their own vehicles as taxis.
