

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 13 MRSA §3157-A is enacted to read:

6 §3167-A. Additional expenditure of ministerial funds

8 Twenty percent of the ministerial funds held in trust by a
10 town or corporation existing under section 3162 may be expended
12 as provided under section 3167 every 5 years.

14 SUMMARY

 This bill authorizes the use of 20% of ministerial funds held in trust.
