

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §54 is enacted to read:

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§54. Revision date required on forms

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All state agencies, to the maximum extent practical, shall include on any form that is used by the public a revision date indicating when a form was revised.

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SUMMARY

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This bill requires all state agencies to include a revision date on any form used by the public.
