

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7827, sub-§16, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, §1, is amended to read:

A. Every snowmobile shall must have mounted on the front at least one headlight capable of casting a white beam for a distance of at least 100 feet directly ahead of the snowmobile~~+-and.~~
