## **SUMMARY**

This bill provides for the continuation of dioxin monitoring in the State's waters through the year 2002. The Governor has established a goal that dischargers reduce their dioxin discharges to equal or below background levels by the year 2000. The dioxin program is the means for the State to assess this goal. The primary method to assess dioxin is through the analysis of fish tissue and it takes several years for fish tissue to show a response to the changes in dioxin levels.
