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

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 and 2, is repealed.

8 **SUMMARY**

10 The Task Force on Defense Realignment and the Economy was
12 created in 1991 to monitor reductions in federal defense spending
14 and military base realignments, coordinate statewide responses to
16 these reductions and develop a plan to reduce the State's defense
dependency. Because the legislative charge of the task force has
been met and no further military base closures are anticipated,
the continuation of the task force is no longer necessary nor
desirable.
