8	The Maine State Retirement System is required by law to present its annual operating budget to the Legislature for
10	approval. This bill is the system's 4th annual budget. The budget is for the fiscal year 1997-98.
12	The bill identifies the system's Personal Services costs and
14	its costs for All Other operating expenses.
16	The bill presents the attribution of expenses to the 3 system member and employer categories: General Fund; Non-General
18	Fund; and Participating Local District and Group Life Insurance.
