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## **SUMMARY**

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This amendment clarifies that the removal of instant lottery ticket vending machines must occur within 30 days of the expiration of any contractual agreement on the placement of the machines. The intent of the transition provision is to avoid any contract buyout and only remove vending machines as the contract expires. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
