	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §374, sub-§1, ¶G, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 505,
4	§2, is amended to read:
6	G. The number or types of locations at which tickets or shares may be sold except that the commission may not
8	authorize the sale of instant lottery tickets by vending machines;
10	
12	Sec. 2. Transition. Vending machines for the sale of instant lottery tickets authorized by Public Law 1995, chapter 368, Part WW must be removed from their locations within 30 days after the
14	effective date of this Act.

	This bill removes the authority of the State Lottery
20	Commission to place vending machines for the sale of instant lottery tickets. Existing machines authorized by the 117th
22	Legislature must be removed within 30 days after the effective

date of this law.
